Let's Talk Ticks

Why Tick Bites Can Make You Very Sick

In the fall of 2011, I was bitten by a tick. I had been bitten before. The first time was bad. The second time was a nightmare.

The first bite occurred about five years ago. Within a week, toxins from the tick had entered my system. The right side of my torso became swollen to twice the normal size. The skin around the area became extremely infected with poisons from the bite.

Eventually, I was discharged and sent home with a whole host of medications. I was as weak as a kitten. Most of my time for the next month was spent in bed.

Happily, I've had a full recovery and am now telling everyone about my tick repellent program. It really works!
